



Invitation to The Open European HTM & Freestyle Championships 2013

The Dutch dog dancing organization NDDB (Nederlandse Dog Dance Bond) invites you to the Open European HTM & Freestyle Championships 2013, which will be held on the 28th and 29th of September 2013 in Burgum, The Netherlands.

National Team

Each participating country can enter a National Team consisting of four Heelwork To Music and four Freestyle dog and handler teams. Each participating team can have a named reserve (travelling or non-travelling) in each discipline. The reserve will only compete should one of the other participants on the team withdraw a dog from competition at the latest during the morning briefing on the day of the competition.

To be eligible for a team score that will count towards the team championship a country should enter at least three competitors in a discipline. Should a country enter less than three competitors in a discipline, they will still be able to compete for a place in the individual finals.

The competition is open to all dogs with or without a pedigree. Entries submitted by a National Member Organization of the FCI or a National Organization with a close relationship to the FCI will be given priority over other entries from that country, if submitted before the 28th of July 2013. The closing date for entries is August 28, 2013.

Program

28th September 2013

The Open European HTM Championships for teams and individuals. The Team Championship will be held in the morning and the Individual Final in the afternoon.

29th September 2013

The Open European Freestyle Championships for teams and individuals. The Team Championship will be held in the morning and the Individual Final in the afternoon.

Winner of the Open European Championship

Winner of the Open European Team Championship in Heelwork To Music will be the country whose 3 highest scoring competitors have the combined highest scores from the first competition day. Winner of the Open European Team Championship in Freestyle will be the country whose 3 highest scoring competitors have the combined highest scores from the first competition day. Please note that only the 3 highest scoring dog and handler teams from each country's scores will count when the team winners are found.

Winner of the Individual Open European Championship in Heelwork to Music will be the competitor with the combined highest score from the qualifying heat and the Individual Final.



Winner of the Individual Open European Championship in Freestyle will be the competitor with the combined highest score from the qualifying heat and the Individual Final.

Competition grounds

The competition will take place indoors on carpet in a well defined competition ring. The size of the ring and the judges' seating will be announced no later than 4 weeks before the competition.
